- [AHECTA](#), **Association of Higher Education Campus Television Administrators**: ACUTA and AHECTA have co-sponsored an audio seminar in the past and continue to consider future co-sponsorships and other collaborations to benefit both memberships.
- [ASCA](#), **Association for Student Conduct Administration**: ACUTA and ASCA will be co-sponsoring a webinar to be held August 12, 2010 on "Copyright Provisions: Higher Education Opportunity Act."
- [ATIS](#), **Alliance for Telecommunications Industry Solutions**: ACUTA collaborated with ATIS to develop the ACUTA/ATIS Hurricane Preparedness Checklist and the university number database.
- [BICSI](#): ACUTA representatives have been appointed to BICSI committees as subject matter experts on higher education. ACUTA and BICSI also exchange publications and invite representatives to events when appropriate.
- [CHEMA](#), **The Council of Higher Education Management Associations**: ACUTA representatives regularly attend meetings with the 30+ CHEMA association members who represent higher education administrative professionals across the board. ACUTA regularly collaborates with other CHEMA member associations in regards to speaking opportunities and event promotion.
- [EDUCAUSE](#): In an effort to cooperate on legislative and regulatory initiatives, a representative of ACUTA serves on the EDUCAUSE Network Policy Council and a representative of EDUCAUSE serves on the ACUTA Legislative and Regulatory Affairs Committee. Representatives of each association are also regularly invited to speak at the other's events.
- [Internet2](#): ACUTA and Internet2 are both members of each other's organizations. ACUTA periodically invites I2 representatives to speak at events and ACUTA representatives participate at I2 events as speakers as well.

ACUTA representatives sponsor and participate in their student case study presentations and student paper awards as judges.
