How can I get the most from the educational sessions?

- One of the greatest benefits of attending an ACUTA event is developing relationships with colleagues at other institutions. Get to know as many other attendees as possible. Introduce yourself to anyone you haven't already met.
- The list of attendees e-mailed to you before the event includes phone numbers and e-mail addresses. Follow up with new friends after you return to work.
- Feel free to contact presenters after the meeting for additional information. Their contact information is on the attendee list.
- Most of the educational sessions provide content about technology implementations on university campuses. Presenters are asked not to promote the use of specific products or vendors. At 4:00 p.m. each day, corporate presentations allow corporate affiliates to offer more specific information about their products and services. Attendees generally find both the breakout sessions and corporate presentations to be very relevant and of high quality.
- Each attendee is registered to attend sessions in only one of the two concurrent tracks. However, you may attend sessions in the other track if you choose. Your agenda lists sessions being offered in both tracks. Handouts for both tracks are available online.
- Most presenters provide copies of their slides prior to the seminar. After the seminar, ACUTA posts updated materials on the website (<http://www.acuta.org/slides>).
